Holy Wisdom Monastery is the home and workplace of the Benedictine Women of Madison, an ecumenical monastic community. The sisters welcome guests and encourage everyone to share in their life of prayer, hospitality, justice and care for the earth. At Holy Wisdom Monastery, activities are inclusive, ecumenical, respectful of creation and considerate of others needs for contemplation and prayer. Respectful use of the facility is required to maintain the simple, contemplative and prayerful atmosphere.



All guests are welcome regardless of religion, sex, age, nationality or ethnicity.

Funeral and Memorial Service/Visitation Rates

Rates for funeral and memorial services include the use of the Assembly Room and Gathering Area, as well as the Hospitality Room for the family throughout the event. ***Sunday Assembly Member pricing available*.

Reception/Luncheon Rates

Holy Wisdom Monastery has a professional chef on-site and will cater your luncheon. If the family wishes to host a reception/luncheon after the service the reservation rates for the reception include, the Guest Dining Room, the Gathering Area, and the Hospitality Room. Actual food costs are determined separately. (See menu on last page) <u>Guests are not allowed to bring in their own food</u>. Outside caterers accepted on a case-by-case basis.

Guest Dining Room Fee



Officiants:

At Holy Wisdom Monastery we ask you to provide your own officiant to preside at the service. We are able to provide suggestions for officiants if you need assistance or guidance.

Service Style Options:

Every family is different, and not everyone wants the same type of funeral or memorial service. We give you the flexibility to create whatever service you wish in order to honor your loved one. The service may be elaborate or simple, public or private, religious or secular. *We offer a live streaming service in the Assembly Room for a \$100 fee to allow guests that are unable to attend in person to be a part of the service.*

Setup for the Service:

The Assembly Room has a seating capacity of 300 people. The chairs, organ and piano may not be moved or removed for a funeral or memorial service. The family may request the monastery staff move the altar to allow room for the casket or a table for photos and memorabilia. Only a Holy Wisdom staff member may move the furniture as care must be given to the floors and walls when moving the furniture.

Hospitality Room for Family:

The private Hospitality Room will be provided for the family throughout the event. The Hospitality Room has a private handicap accessible restroom and sink available. Snacks and bottled drinks may be brought and set up in the Hospitality Room for the family. This room must be cleared of all food, drink, and personal items by the family immediately following the event.

Music:

It is appropriate to include instrumental and/or vocal music as part of the funeral or memorial service. Holy Wisdom Monastery does not provide soloists or instrumentalists. It is the family's responsibility to contact and pay the musicians. The Assembly Room and Gathering Space are connected to a sound system which can play a CD or music from a phone, tablet or computer.

Florists:

Arrangements for flowers at the funeral or memorial service are the responsibility of the family. The family is responsible for coordinating the delivery of the flowers. The florist or family is expected to remove all floral decorations promptly following the event.

Sound System:

The acoustics in the Assembly Room are exceptional and microphones may not be needed. If the family does want to use the sound system, it is included in the room rental fee. Up to four hand-held or lapel wireless mics are available.

Food and Beverages:

Food and beverages are not allowed in the Assembly Room, although they are allowed in other areas of the building, such as the Hospitality Room, Gathering Area and Guest Dining Room.

Communion Elements:

Holy Wisdom Monastery does not provide communion elements for the service. Families or presiders may bring their own communion elements.

Accessibility:

Holy Wisdom Monastery is wheelchair accessible.

Parking:

Parking for your service is available in the monastery parking lot, along the driveway leading up to the monastery, behind the monastery and in the retreat and guest house parking.



Guidelines for the Reception/Luncheon



Room Usage:

The Guest Dining Room, Gathering Area, Hospitality Room, outside patio and bathrooms are available for use during the reception/luncheon. The Guest Dining Room can seat up to 150.

Decorating:

The family may provide any decorations for the reception. Floral arrangements may be placed on the tables and any additional decorations must be discussed and approved by the Guest Services Coordinator before the reception/luncheon.

Audio/Visual Items:

Holy Wisdom Monastery is equipped with a sound system that can play recorded music in the gathering space and/or the guest dining room for no additional fee. The guest dining room has a retractable projection screen that guests may use to show videos or a PowerPoint presentation. The guest dining room may also be set up for a total of two wireless microphones. Computers are not supplied.

<u>Alcohol:</u>

Holy Wisdom Monastery does not own a liquor license. However, alcohol may be served during the event as long as the event is a private event not open to the public. Alcohol consumption must be done in an appropriate and respectful way in keeping with the monastery's policies. Due to state and local laws, Holy Wisdom Monastery and its staff cannot provide, handle, serve or pour any alcoholic beverages. Absolutely no alcohol may be served to guests under the age of 21. Cash bars are not allowed.

All alcohol and any glassware must be provided by the host and should be delivered to the monastery during the host's chosen time block. Outside glassware may not be washed on-site.

Since Holy Wisdom Monastery staff cannot be involved in the service of alcoholic beverages, it is requested that hosts designate individuals to dispose of beverages partially consumed and left behind by guests throughout the event.

For a fee, Holy Wisdom Monastery will provide same day refrigeration, set-up with a table and linen, cleaning, corkscrews, ice and ice bins. *Any event serving alcohol is required to pay this fee.*
